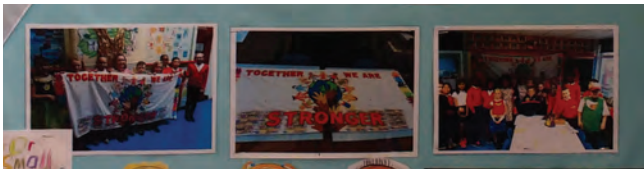
## People UTD day –Saturday October 29th
