

## Phone calls home







Rebekah in 6C has been (safely) exercising daily outdoors as well as completing lots of maths and art work! Well done Rebekah, you're doing a fantastic job!




Imran in 2J has completed lots of fantastic maths work this week. Well done Imran, you're doing a great job and have been sending in lots of your home learning tasks.



Greatwill in 5G has been working hard in science and has made this fantastic model of the solar system! Well done Greatwill, this is really impressive!


Isabella in 6B has completed lots of reasoning maths questions this week, which require a lot of brain power and focus! Keep up the great work Isabella.
