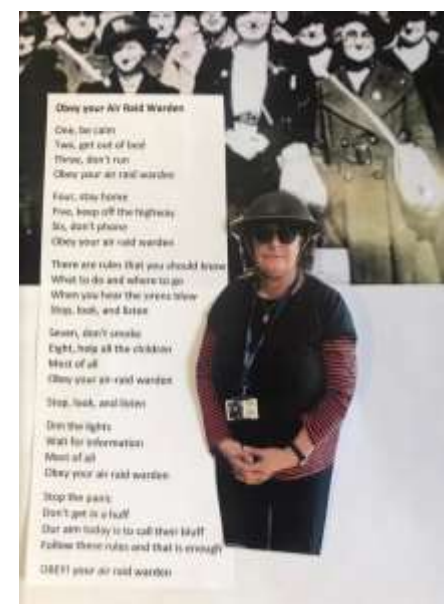

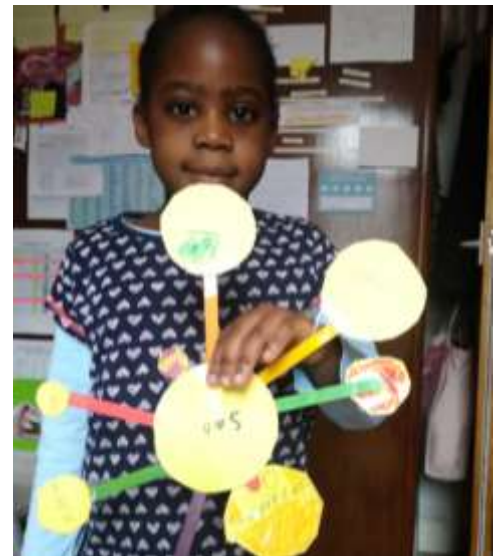
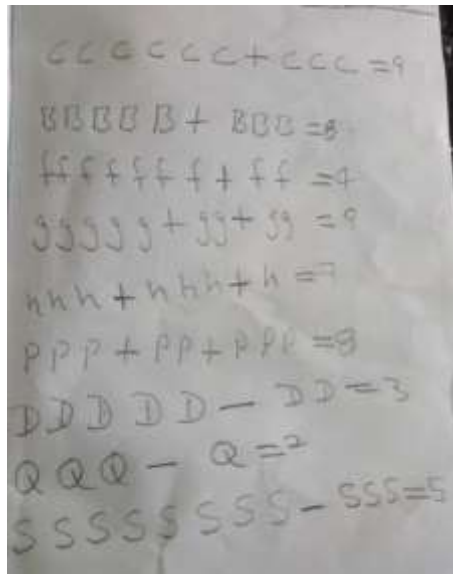
## Home learning

Omoede in 1H has been busy at home completing maths sums, using letters of the alphabet. Well done Omoede, keep up the great work!

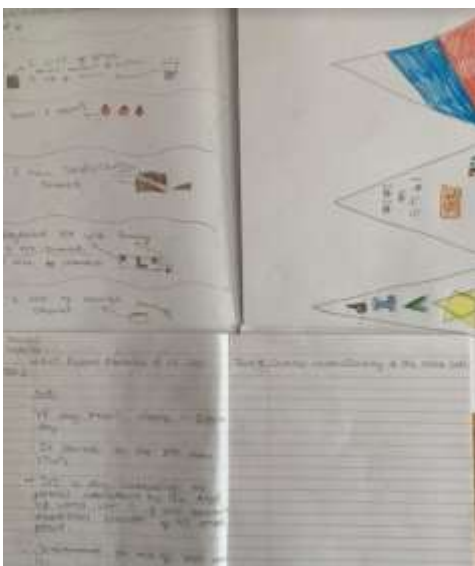


Sarah in 2J has made her very own solar system and I think we can all agree that it looks fantastic. Well done Sarah, you have captured each planet brilliantly.
