
If you need any further support with FROG or accessing online resources, you can email our computing team and they will be able to give you guidance if the class teacher is not available. This email address will be sent out later in the week.

Keep checking the school website and FROG for new home learning resources, which are being updated daily. These resources can be accessed via any device that has internet access.


Remember to only do as much as you can with what you have and not to worry if you don't manage to do everything.





Hania in 2J has been busy at home practising her times tables and completing lots of multiplications sums. Well done Hania, keep up the great work!





Tobias in 2J has completed his 'Talk for writing' story this week and has drawn some fantastic illustrations to go with it. Great work Tobias, your story is fantastic.
