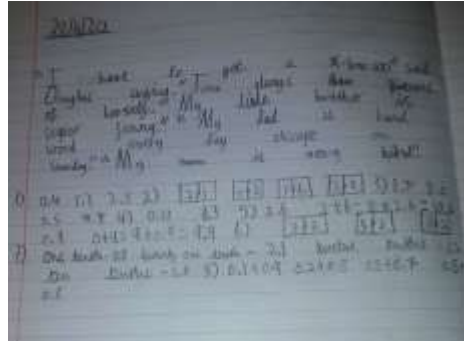
Nathan in 4G has been working really hard creating a hanging rainbow of hope. This looks great Nathan, keep up the great work!
