## Plans for reopening for more children

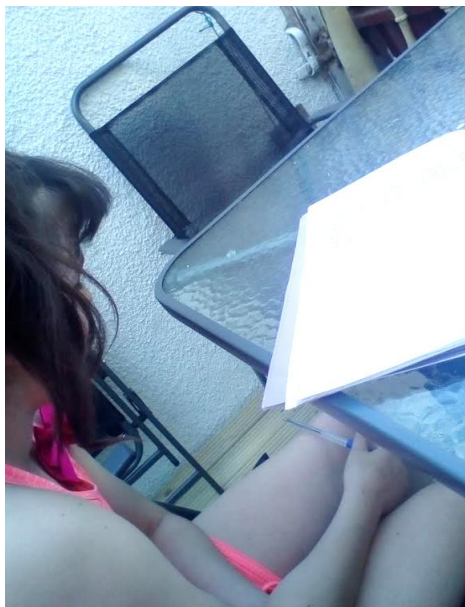
Following the government's confirmation that schools will begin to reopen for more children from 1<sup>st</sup> June, we are now making plans to welcome back year 6 in the week beginning Monday June 15<sup>th</sup>. This return date has been decided on in line with the most recent scientific advice.

Schools have been asked to create a plan which will help to keep our school community as a whole as safe as is possible in the current circumstances. Manchester Local Authority has advised that we are able to set our own course of action and timescales for how and when the school will reopen, subject to certain conditions being met.

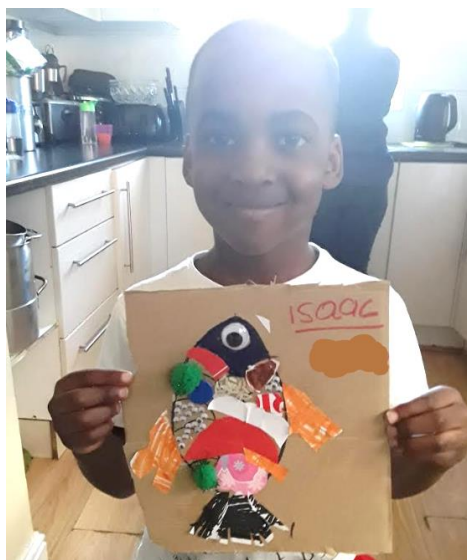

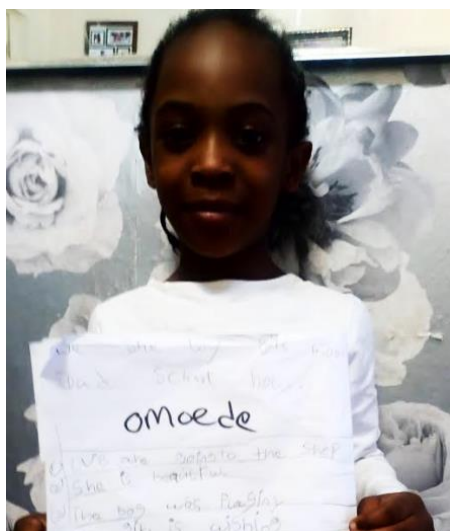


Isaac in reception has put his art skills to the test and made this fantastic fish collage. You should be really proud of this Isaac, it is great!

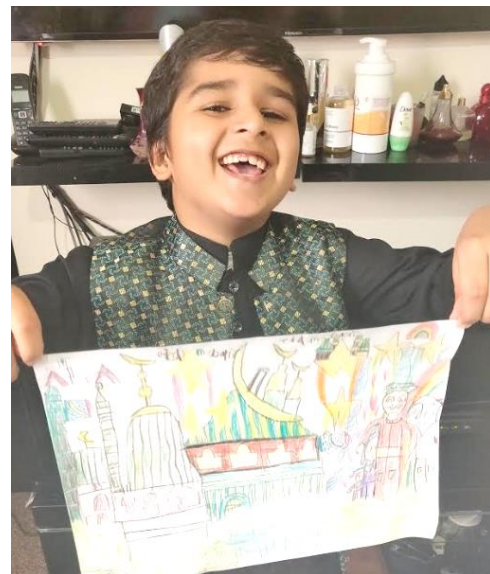
