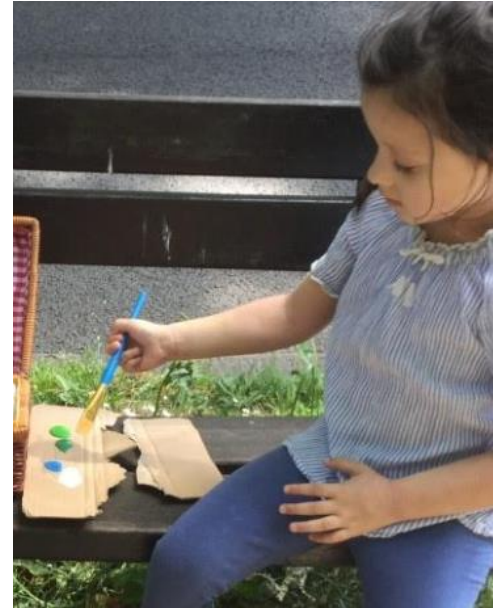


Home learning
