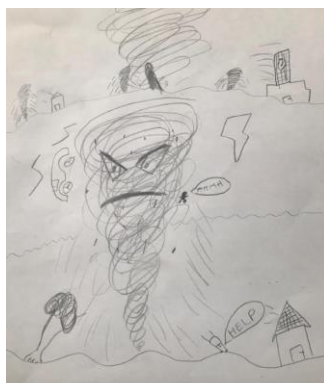
## Year 6 leavers livestream event – Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> July

The livestream event will take place in the week starting 13.7.20 and will follow a similar format as before with songs, dances and poetry which children can learn at home using teaching videos.

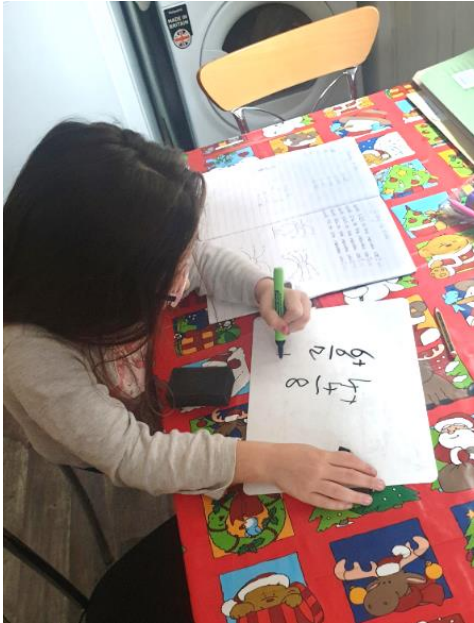
Following feedback from questionnaires and phone calls we have planned family activity packs, so that all children will be able to do the same activities. There will be lots of activities to choose from.

## Home learning

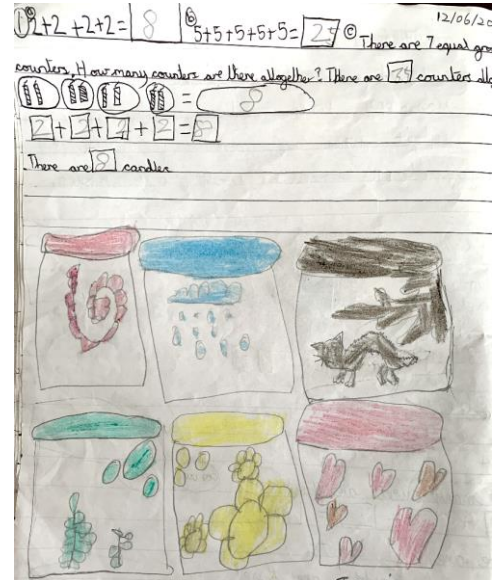
