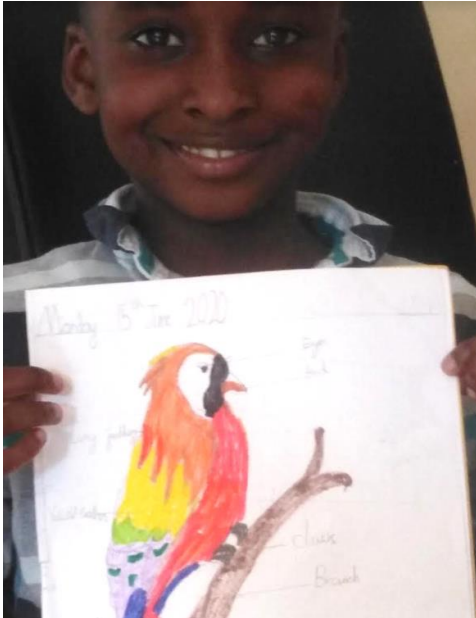
The livestream event will take place in the week starting 13.7.20 and will follow a similar format as before with songs, dances and poetry which children can learn at home using teaching videos.

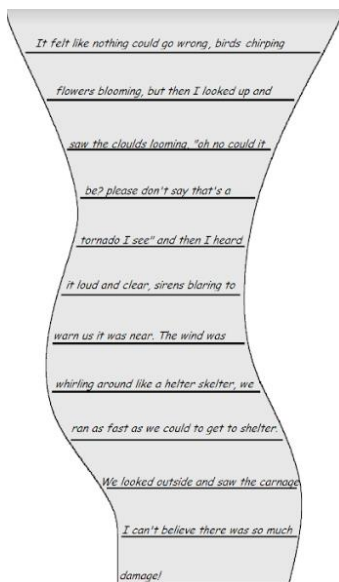
Home learning

Imran in 2J has been using his fantastic art skills this week and had drawn this amazing picture of a parrot! Your colouring technique is great Imran, keep up the great work!

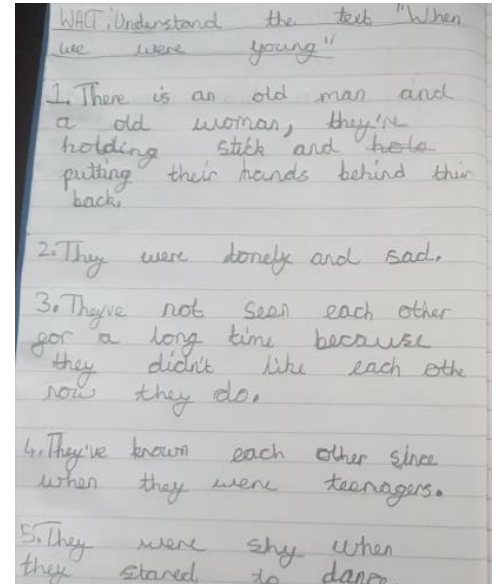
