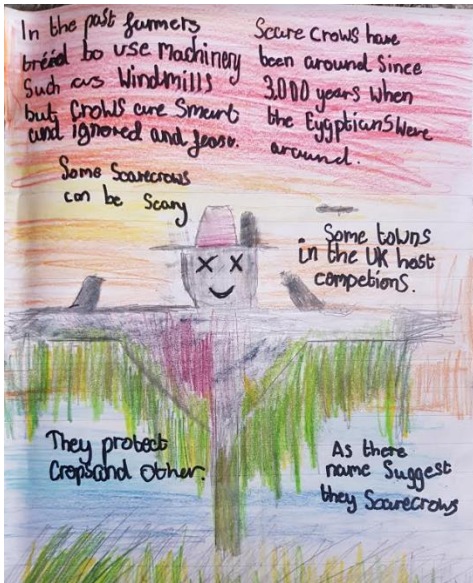
The livestream event will take place in the week starting 13.7.20 and will follow a similar format as before with songs, dances and poetry which children can learn at home using teaching videos.

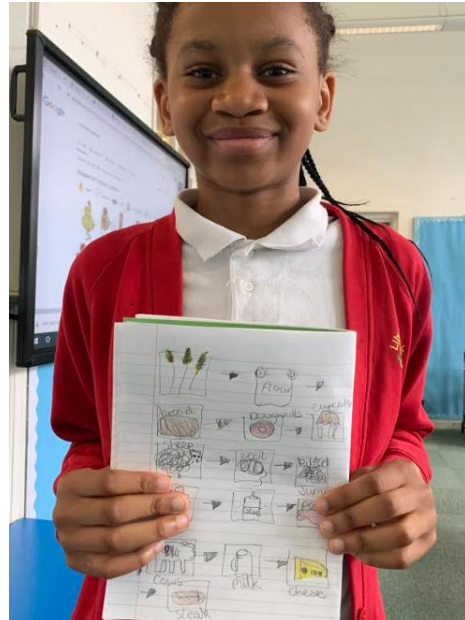
Corey in 1C has drawn some Jaggedy Daggers this week and has come up with some great adjectives to describe them. Well done Corey, keep up the great work!
