We are waiting for the government update on May 28<sup>th</sup>, in order to gain a clearer picture of what is expected of schools.



## UK Cost of the School Day at Home Survey

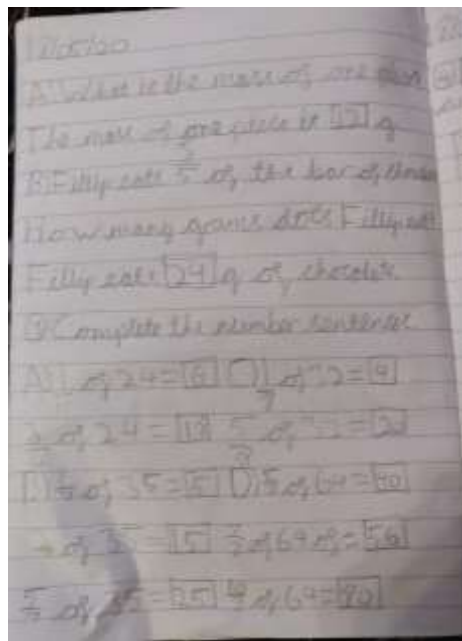
## Home learning
