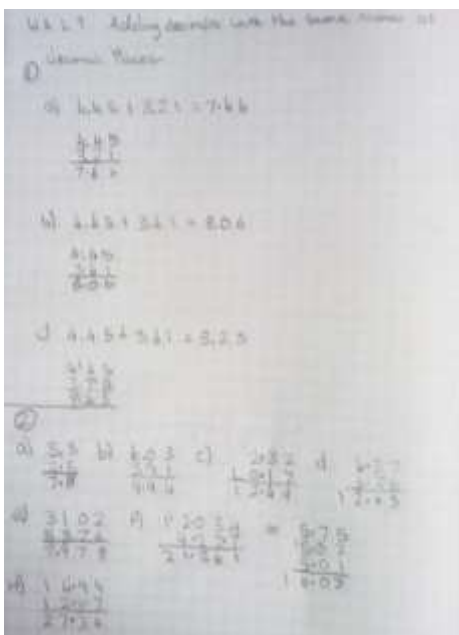


Savannah in 1H has been doing lots of art work at home and is really enjoy getting outside for her daily exercise. You look like you're have lots of fun Savannah!

Khalid in 1C is a maths whizz and has been working really hard understanding fractions this week! Well done Khalid, you are doing a great job!

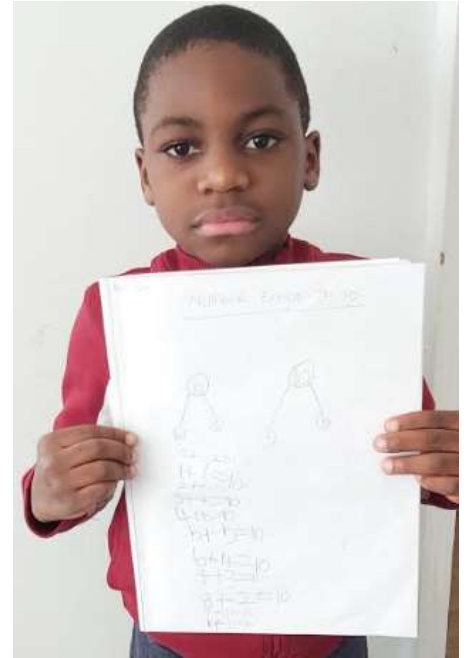


Adam in 2P has been working extremely hard in maths practising multiplication. Keep up the great work Adam, you're doing a fantastic job!
