




Ellis in 2J has been drawing and describing aliens that he has created this week. These look great Ellis, I particularly like the blue square alien!





Kadie in 4S has been busy making VE Day bunting and flags over the past week. You have done a fantastic job Kadie, keep up the great work!

Irenre in 3T has been busy completing maths and English work at home this week. Well done Irenre, you've done great!





Isabella in 6C has been busy baking and building this week. She has made this knex model jet which looks really difficult to put together. Well done Isabella!
