We will keep families updated and as soon as we have any definite information, we will inform you. In the meantime, we ask all families to continue to **stay safe** and **be vigilant**.






Ruth in 5S has carried out her own science experiment this week and written her method and results brilliantly. Well done Ruth, you have done a great job.

Feranmi in 3G has taken on her class fitness challenge and has been doing lots of squats and star jumps. Well done Feranmi, Joe wicks would be impressed!




Ellis in 2J has put his writing skills to the test this week, using a typewriter that his Nana found while having a sort out. I think we have an author in the making Ellis!
