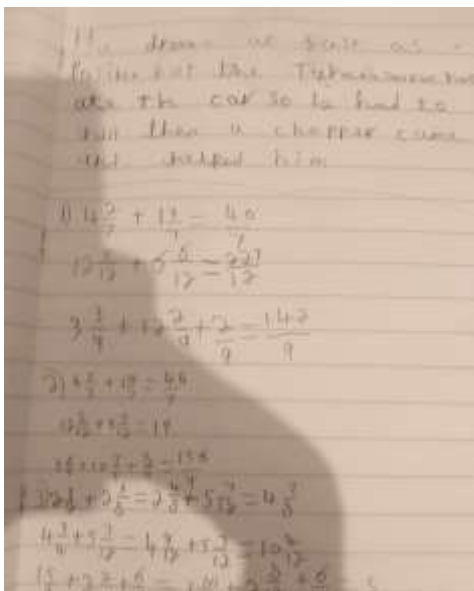


Rehan in 6B has been completing his Lockdown SATs over the last week and has used shells to create this fantastic piece of art work. Well done Rehan!
