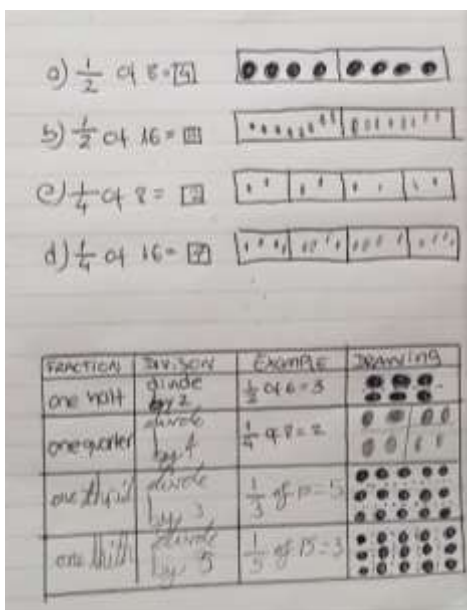


Home learning

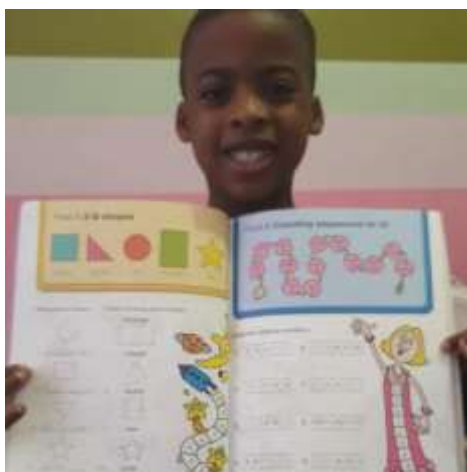
Melissa in 3G has worked really hard with her Maths fractions work that has been set for the start of the summer term! Great work Melissa.
