Thank you to Abdallah's mum for allowing us to share this story with the Lily Lane community.

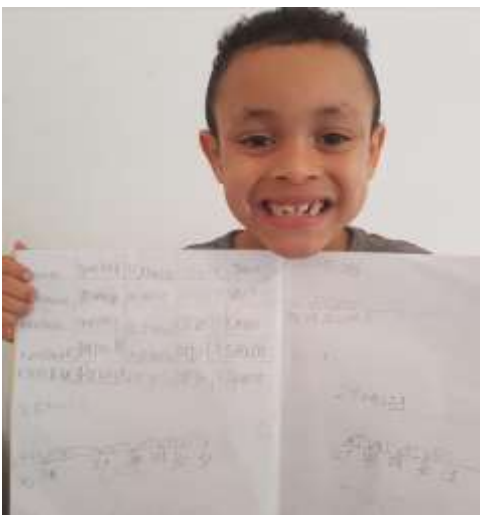
Home learning

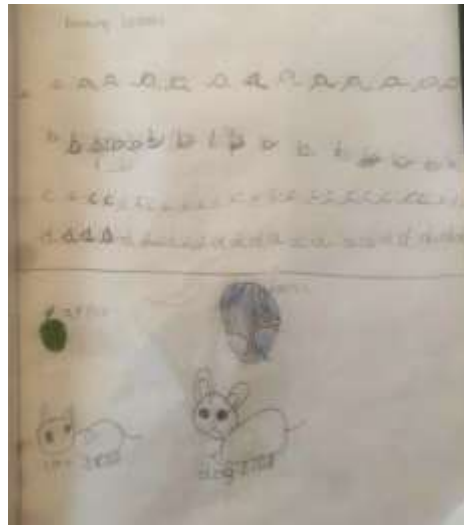


Imran in 2J has been writing about COVID-19 this week so that he doesn't forget his experience in the future. You have used some great vocabulary in your writing Imran. Well done!
