Stop Game

Stop Game is a fun game for students of all ages! Students have to select a letter to start and write the words of the six different categories (occupation, fruit, food, things, nationalities and clothing) that starts with that letter. The player that gets most correct words wins! It is a nice activity for improving the vocabulary of our students!

Rules: Students write the words in the correct categories and when one of them completes the categories, he/she shouts STOP. You can add more categories according to the level of your students. This game aims to help students remember the largest number of vocabulary words. Students then check their scores. If more than one person has a word, it is worth 1 point. If no one else has the word, it is worth 2.
