Task 2: WALT: Gain an insight into how hairstyles have changed over time.

Task 3: WALT: Illustrate a WW2 scene, with accompanying descriptive writing.

Art and Writing focus around WW2 images. Choose a scene: either a Blitz skyline, celebrations of the war ending / VE day, a portrait of soldiers, battlefields, Women's efforts at war, or another scene of Wartime. Sketch and paint (or whatever resources you have) of your scene. Once it is finished, write a description to accompany it.

***Challenge – imagine it is a Big Write and you are really trying to impress with your vocabulary!**

Task 4: WALT: Calculate WW2 costings from a catalogue.
