



Term starts for children - Year 1 to Year 6 Thursday 3rd September 2020

Nursery and Reception

There will be a phased start for Nursery and Reception children. This information is being provided separately to families.

Year 1 to Year 5

For the first two weeks children in Year 1 and Year 5 will be taught in two class bubbles of 15 children. By reducing lunch hour and not having assemblies the amount of taught time will not be significantly reduced. All children will have dinner in school.

Group 1 and 2 8.45am – 1.00pm (not Friday 4th September)

Year 6

Monday to Thursday 9.00am – 3.15pm

For the Autumn Term we are trialling school finishing at lunchtime on Friday for most children (excluding Year 6). This is to enable all class teachers to have their statutory planning, preparation and assessment time and to allow for a deep clean. It will also enable over time to provide enrichment activities, keep up programmes and family workshops on Friday afternoons.

We are keen to start after school clubs and activities as soon as we are able to. They will not start until October at the earliest.
