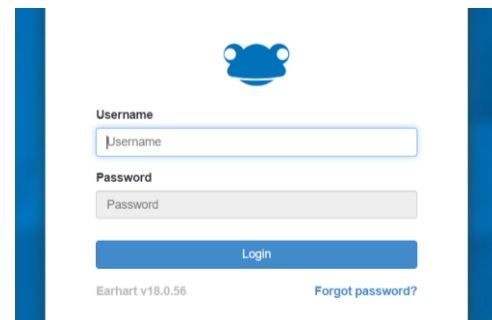

Children should have received their offer of a High School place today. If you haven't received a place or have not been allocated your first choice, you can contact school to discuss your next steps. Alternatively, you can click on the following link and it will advise you what to do next.

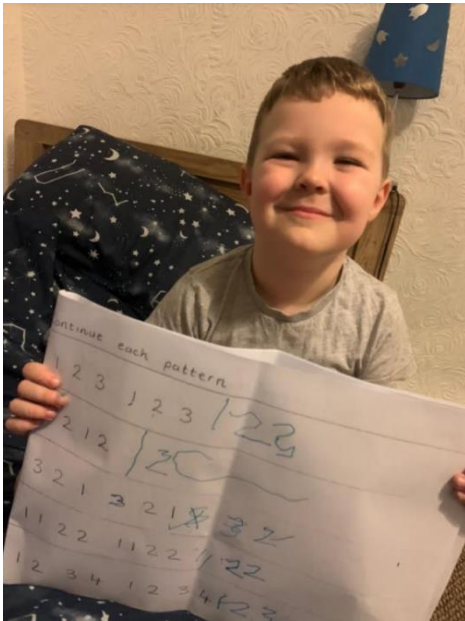

Clicking on the link will tell you how to appeal if you don't agree with your offer. There's no guarantee that you'll get a place in the school you put first. But if you put other schools, and they have places, they will offer your child a place at one of those and put you on the waiting lists for your top preferences.

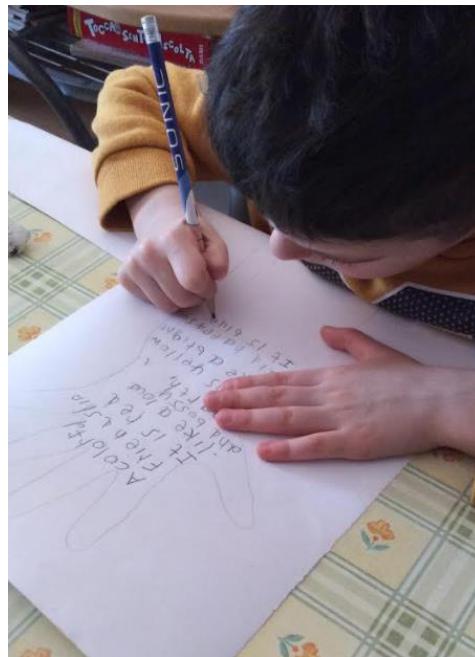

Home learning

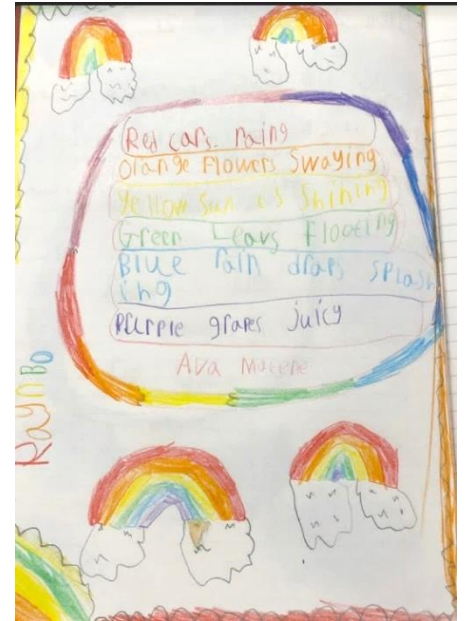
