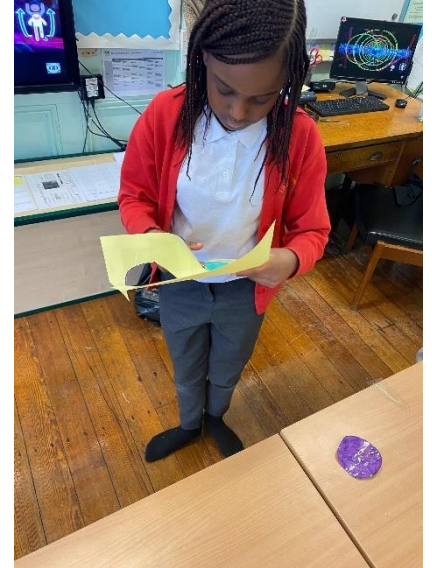
## Home learning

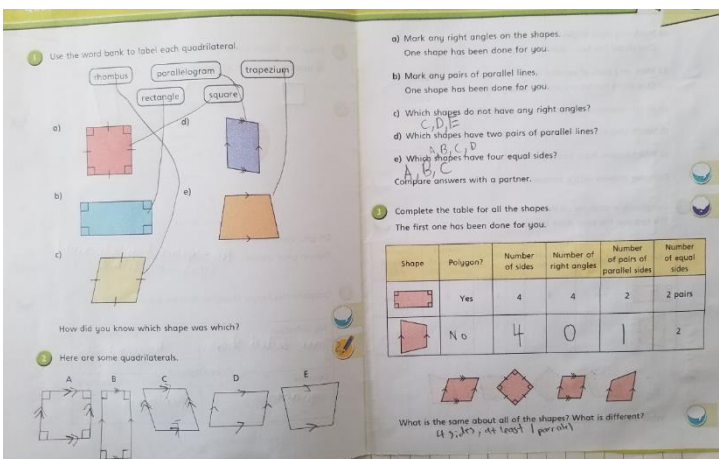


Lyla in 5M has produced a fantastic piece of anime inspired art this week of Little Red Riding Hood! Great work Lyla, this is amazing!
