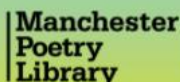


This event will be on Youtube Live (with invited zoom guests). All the teaching resources for the event can be found on the Write Out Loud website writeoutloud.net

The poetry party will include children from all over the country joining in with a mixture of songs, dance and of course poetry. It will feature performances and games from featured writers, young poets and musicians.

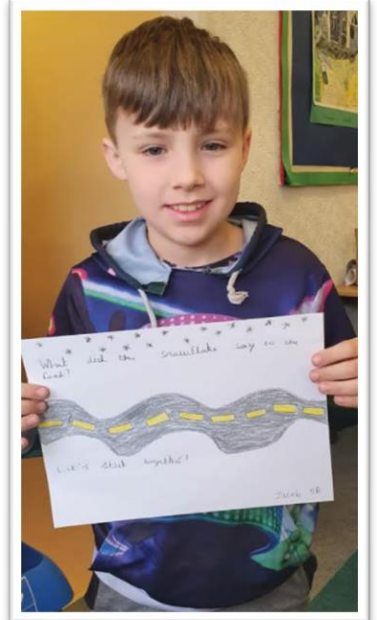

My Happy Place

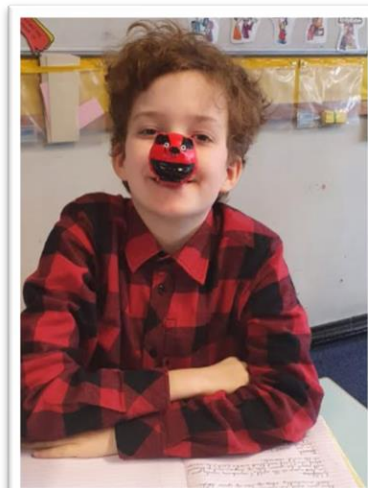
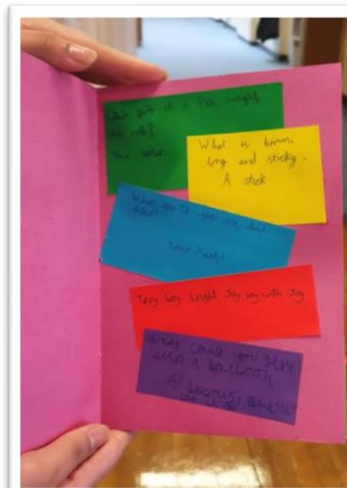
