Subitise

Provide opportunities for your child to recognise up to three objects instantly.



Positional Language

Talk to your child about finding different things using the vocabulary 'in, on, under, behind and next to'.



Geography

Talk to your child about where they live. Tell them their house number and street name and their town.



Reading

Continue to read and return your child's library club book every Friday.



Understanding the World

Help your child by talking about the similarities and differences between them and other children from around the world, for example the clothes they wear, the weather, different celebrations and the food they eat

Phonics

Keep practising your Read, Write Inc sounds at home.

Sound lots of words out and ask your child to blend the sounds to say the word for example 'c a t' = cat.

Writing

We will be sending home some stress balls that the children will make. Please encourage your child to squeeze them at home to help build the muscles in their hands to help improve their pencil grip.

Help your child practise to write their name.

Investigation

Go on a nature walk - can you spot any birds, flowers or insects? Observe the weather! How is it changing? Why is it changing?
