Go on a walk around your local area with a grown up. Draw and label the plants you see.

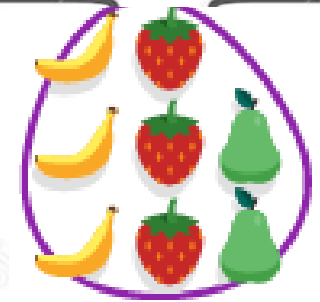
Login to Purple Mash then use the following pathway to create your own graphs:
