Turn a well known myth or legend into a cartoon story strip.

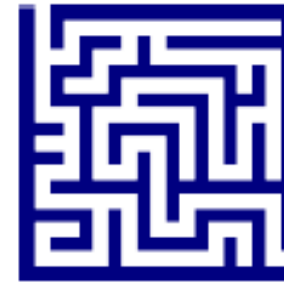
Here are some stories you could look up:

Find out about the Greek alphabet and present your findings in an exciting way.



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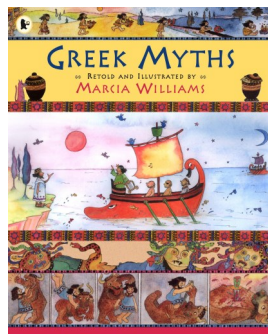
Complete one of the comprehension activities.
