




### **#Half Termly Attendance Winners**

#### #Year 4 & 5 Manchester United Tournament

On Tuesday 23rd May, Lily Lane Y4/5 took part in the Manchester United Football Tournament at The Cliff Training Ground. We had 4 qualifying matches to play in Group 1 and there was some excellent incisive football on display. At one point, after conceding in a match with little time left, it looked like we may not qualify for the knockout rounds. However, sheer work rate and determination meant that the players fought to the end and managed to get a result that their play merited. We finished the group stage top, undefeated and on +16 goal difference so confidence was high going into the semi-final v St Margaret Ward. An explosive start to the match meant that Lily Lane were 2-0 up with less than 2 minutes played. We continued to play at a high tempo and the opposition GK made magnificent saves throughout the match. Probing passes and crosses and a robust defensive performance meant the game finished 4-0 and we were through to the final. In the final, we would meet the team, Park View, who almost beat us in the qualifying round so knew it would once again be a tough game with nothing taken for granted. The final began with Lily Lane testing the GK several times but without managing to get on the scoresheet. We had to battle hard with great tracking back and interceptions from the whole team meaning that the opposition were limited in attacking chances. We were always a threat and eventually after some quick passing we got the goal our play deserved. This spurred the players on and we quickly scored once again to give us a 2-0 advantage. Park View didn't give up and they scored a late goal to bring the score back to 2-1 but Lily Lane saw the game out to become champions!
